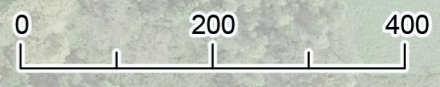




SITE PLAN

VISION STATEMENT

Develop the vacant lot previously owned and operated as a hatchery and lake by the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission to provide various recreation and natural resource conservation offerings for public use.

The items requested are individually listed in the "Goals and Objectives" below and include: multi-modal access throughout the various ecosystems on site, space for conservation efforts, an area for educational presentations, interpretive signage with relevant historic, cultural, and environmental information.

The intent of the site is to become a regional destination for outdoor recreation, conservation, and educational opportunities—as an alternative to the traditional group play and ball fields offered at other County owned recreation sites.

Proposed "water lily" shaped stone steps out into water habitat

Proposed 100' long, 5' wide habitat access bridge

Proposed Pavilion (Education Center and Picnic Area) with access to various aquatic resources and interpretive displays (historic and environmental)

Proposed Forest Stewardship Plan prescribing growth and management measures for the entire site (including several conservation areas)

Proposed gravel multi-modal trail 8' wide meeting 2010 ADA standards

Proposed wetland mitigation habitat installation

Proposed viewing location for native habitat and species. Includes bird blind and interpretive sign.

Proposed gravel picnic area and marsh access for anglers (over existing gravel). Includes benches, picnic tables, and interpretive signage

Proposed habitat and species viewing platform with interpretive sign.

Proposed 15' asphalt access road (over existing gravel road) meeting 2010 ADA standards

HANKINS POND

Existing access gate to remain

Proposed bird blind with interpretive sign; offering meets 2010 ADA standards for accessibility for all.

Proposed asphalt parking area (over existing gravel) with ADA designated spots and a two-door comfort station

Proposed paved multi-modal trail across top of dam, meeting 2010 ADA standards (includes a 40' long, 10' wide bridge over outlet breach)

Interpretive signage (historic and environmental)

Proposed hydrant
